Camp patriot's proposed thirty-thousand square foot rustic log lodge will overlook crystal clear Lake Kooconasa. Nestled in the majestic Kootenai River Valley, the lodge will boast 20 luxurious lake view rooms. Additionally, the Camp Patriot Lodge will be equipped with a state-of-the-art kitchen and dining area. The entire lodge will be in compliance with the American Disabilities Act offering full access to the weightlifting and fitness rooms. For on site emergency medical care of our veteran guests, Camp Patriot will have a basic medical facility. For more extensive medical needs, a helicopter landing pad will be located near the lodge.
