Larry's 30 years of experience began in 1969 when he started National Carburetor Exchange in a 600 square foot building rebuilding and installing carburetors in South Florida.

In 1974 the business had grown to become a Warehouse Distributor carrying all performance lines and selling wholesale only. In 1985 he started serving on the Advisory Council for Triad Systems Corp. and in 1988 became Area Director for the Performance Warehouse Association.

One of his accomplished goals was to bring electronic price updates to over 90% of the Performance Lines. He was elected in July 1994 to the SEMA Board of Directors. In 1996 he was elected again to the Board of Directors of the PWA.

Larry is the only person in history to serve on all three Association Boards at the same time (AWDA, PWA and SEMA). Larry still lives in South Florida with his wife and he has three sons.
